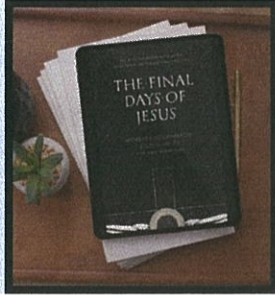


### EXPRESSION OF SYMPATHY


