



The Scoop on FBCS K4...

Children can attend K4

1. 3 days a week, all day
2. 5 days a week, all day

Children who come three (3) days a week receive all of the foundational material for the week. Children who come five (5) days a week will do enrichment and supplemental activities that build on those foundational lessons.

A day in the life of a K4 student:

The typical day in our K4 classroom includes a more academic-based morning time, leaving our afternoon more relaxed and less taxing. Bathroom breaks are scheduled in both the morning and afternoon.

Morning Activities:

- School begins at 8:30
- Coloring page
- Carpet time (Calendar, Pledges, Songs)
- Gym class
- Small snack
- Bible Lesson
- Language/Phonics—a letter each week and learning its formation and sound
- Math/Numbers—write a number each week 1-20, counting, number concepts
- Lunch

Afternoon Activities:

- Recess in the gym or on the playground
- Small group centers, art, finish papers, or projects—depends on each day.
- Music Class or Library Class (1x or 2x/wk)
- Story Time
- Rest Time
- Snack Time
- Play Time
- Clean-up & Pack-up for home
- Carline Dismissal around 3:10

Supplies for K4:

- Two boxes of only **Crayola brand** crayons (24 ct) & plastic pencil box
- Foldable nap mat—available in the fall at Target, Wal-Mart, or Fleet Farm
- Two plastic pocket folders—to bring papers to and from school daily
- Tub of Pampers Baby Wipes, tub of Clorox Wipes, large box of Kleenex
- Box of bandaids & 8 oz. pump hand sanitizer
- One box of Ziploc bags—snack, sandwich, quart, or gallon
- Back pack or book bag—large enough to carry the folder and lunch box
- Glue sticks (3 pk)
- Tennis shoes (Velcro or slip on) —to be left at school for use in the gym
- Extra full set of clothes in a bag (labeled) —to keep at school for accidents or spills
- Lunch—bring a packed lunch or you can order hot lunch each week
- Classroom snacks to share, eg.: Goldfish, Ritz, animal crackers, fruit snacks, etc.

Before K4 Begins...

- 👉 Help your child to become "Bathroom Independent." Children entering K4 must be potty trained and should only need very minimal assistance in the restroom.
- 👉 Talk with your child about going to school. Make going to school and learning an exciting adventure for your child. Explain to your child that you will be taking him/her to school each morning and that you will return to pick him/her up at the end of the day. Remind him/her of all of the friends he/she will make in school and the great things he/she will learn and do while in K4.
