- **God's Blessings on FBCS**—We are excited about our enrollment numbers for next year, and we continue to receive admissions inquiries. We praise the Lord for His goodness and blessings upon our school. We plan to purchase more Chromebooks for use in our secondary grades for next year and have purchased a lot of better desks to replace the smaller wooden ones in our secondary classrooms as well. We will be purchasing 15 new magnetic boards, a new mimeo smartboard for a new classroom, a couple of projectors for classrooms that still need them, and we will also be buying three new document cameras (they work like a transparency projector, but project an image on paper up on the whiteboard).
- **Summer Reading Challenge Cards**—went home with your student's Lexile level noted. **Please encourage your child to READ this summer at or above their Lexile level.** Reading books that are 5–50 pts above the student's Lexile level will stretch their reading comprehension and improve their overall scholastic ability.
