



## Fourth Baptist Home Game Guidelines

### **Athletic Event Covid Protocol:**

1. Masks or facial coverings must be worn by all fans attending our games.
2. Masks must be worn by athletes who are not playing in the game (while on the bench) and by coaches seated (not the head coach). Players in the game need not wear masks.
3. Please leave the bench chairs in the spaces that you find them. Do not move them next to each other.
4. Due to the capacity limitations set forth by our governor, we are only able to allow immediate family of the athletes in the gym during their children's respective game.
5. We will be live streaming every game so those outside the immediate family will still be able to watch the games at home. The stream will be on our school's official Facebook page.
6. We will clear the gym in between each of our games to sanitize the benches, bleachers and scoring table.
7. We will have both sets of bleachers out so that fans can physically distance. Immediate family may sit together, but please allow for adequate space for non-family members. There is plenty of space for this to occur.
8. Upon entrance to the gymnasium, hand sanitizer will be available. We have a number of face coverings (masks, face shields, and chin shields) in supply for those who may have forgotten.
9. We will take the temperatures of all participants and fans entering the gym. If anyone has a temperature of 100.0° F or more, we will ask that fan to wait 5-10 minutes. We will retake the temperature. If their temperature is lower than 99.0° F, the fan or participant may enter the event. If it is higher, the individual may not stay for the game and must go home.
10. Families should sit together in the gymnasium/game space and should practice physical distancing from other families and fans in attendance. Children must stay with their family in the gymnasium for the duration of the game to limit the spread of potential disease. Unsupervised children (in hallways/common areas) will be asked to return to their families in the gymnasium by the school or athletic staff.

Please honor our requests as guests on our campus. It is a privilege for all of us to be able to be a part of this event. Thank you for your help, cooperation, and support.
